Our Services

Family Dispute Resolution

Professional support for families who need help resolving disputes about children or financial matters. The law requires separating families who have a dispute about children to make a genuine effort to try to sort it out through family dispute resolution (FDR) before filing an application for parenting orders in Court. It is a practical, less stressful and inexpensive way for separating families to sort out these arrangements.

Mediation

Guided negotiation between people in conflict. For example, between teens and parents about behavioural or communication issues, or between siblings about ongoing care & financial arrangements for elderly parents.

Counselling

Skilled and non-judgemental professionals helping individuals, couples and families through emotional problems, dealing with grief, parenting challenges and marital concerns.

Child & Youth Counselling

Assistance and guidance from a compassionate and skilled practitioner who understands how children communicate, the difficulties children face and how best to resolve them.

Psychological Services

Team of psychologists providing sessions at a range locations including schools, community centres and SEPHN.

Family Violence Services

A range of specialist support and counselling services including victims support, financial advocacy and programs for men, adolescents and children.

Financial Counselling and Capability

Practical strategies, support and vital information for people who need help managing their finances, want to learn about managing their money or are struggling with debt.

Family Mental Health Support

Support Services for children, young people and their families to learn healthier ways of dealing with problems arising from changes within the family like divorce, moving, or even a new baby. (Frankston to Mornington only)

Respecting Elders

A range of services to assist older people in conflict resolution and support with their families, siblings, friends carers and or/ professional service providers.

Group Programs and Community Education

- Providing couples, parents and carers with relationship education to enhance their family environment.
- STAR: school based programs for students to develop their skills in relationships, resilience, emotions and working with others.
